## A. Qualifications & Abilities

- 3. Maintain accurate attendance records and documentation
- 4. Supervise occasional outdoor play activities that are both safe and fun for the children
- 5. Manage and enforce safety protocols, including emergency procedures
- 6. Provide support to volunteers and fellow childcare workers
- 7. Lead children in age-appropriate Bible stories, prayer, and discussions that encourage their understanding of Jesus
